Respect the Game

- Play for the love of the sport—not for personal gain or recognition.
- Maintain a positive attitude and try your best, whether winning or losing.
- Be a positive role model for teammates, younger players, and your community.

Respect for Coaches and Teammates

- Listen to your coaches and teammates, and treat them with respect.
- Celebrate your teammates' successes and support them through challenges
- Work together to achieve team goals and always put the team first.
- Attend all practices and games. If you can't attend, notify your coach in advance.

Respect for Opponents and Umpires

- Treat opponents and umpires with respect before, during and after the game.
- Avoid taunting, trash-talking, or any unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Do not argue with umpire calls or question their authority.
- Shake hands with the opposing team after each game as a sign of good sportsmanship.

Safety and Well-being

- Prioritize your safety and the safety of others during practices and games.
- Report any injuries or unsafe conditions to your coach or a league official immediately.
- Wear all required equipment and follow safety guidelines to prevent injury.
